



Ki Kinderophthalmologie = Pediatric Ophthalmology: any ocular disease in patients < 16 years of age including trauma, retinopathy of prematurity (ROP), chronic inflammations, refractive problems and more

0 Orthoptics: conservative and surgical treatment of strabismus and amblyopia in pediatric and adult patients including strabismus surgery, lid surgery

Lo Low Vision: Treatment and visual rehabilitation (Low Vision Aids = LVA) in pediatric and adult patients, congenital / hereditary ocular dieseases leading to low vision (albinism, aniridia, retinal dystrophies etc) and acquired low vision (age related macular degeneration, glaucomatous optic atrophy)

N Neuroophthalmolgy: treating pediatric and adult patients with neurological diseases affecting sensory and / or motor aspects of the eyes (brain tumor, apoplex, paresis of ocular muscles, visual field defects ect).

travelling by car

From Mannheim or Saarbrücken

Leave the A6 motorway at the Homburg exit and drive towards Homburg, following the signs to the university hospital ("Kliniken" or "Universitätskliniken").

From Trier or Koblenz

Take the A8 motorway as far as the Neunkirchen/Saar intersection (Autobahnkreuz Neunkirchen/Saar), where you take the A6 and drive towards Mannheim leaving at the Homburg/Saar exit.
Further directions as above.

From Karlsruhe/Pirmasens

Take the B10 to Pirmasens, then the A8 motorway, leave the A8 at the Einöd exit and continue on B423 towards Homburg, following the signs to the university hospital ("Kliniken" or "Universitätskliniken").

Parking

is available at the main entrance of the university hospital campus (Parkhaus). A free bus service operating within the hospital campus from 7 am until 4 pm departs every fifteen minutes. Each of the following departments has a visitor parking area with parking fees: Internal Medicine II, Eye Clinic, Gynaecology, Paediatric Medicine, Neurology, Neurosurgery, Nuclear Medicine, and Forensic Medicine.
