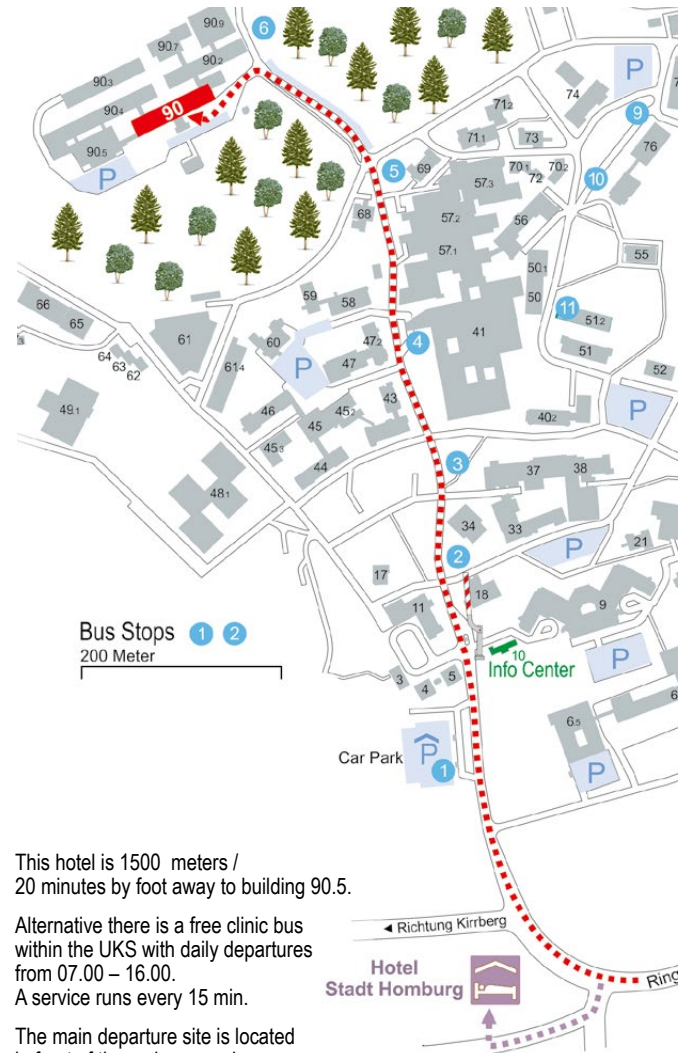

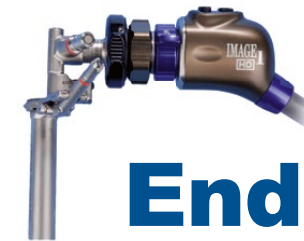
This hotel is 1500 meters / 20 minutes by foot away to building 90.5.

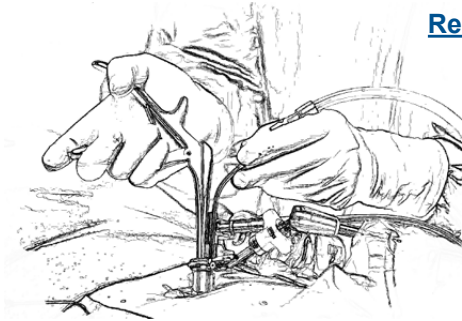

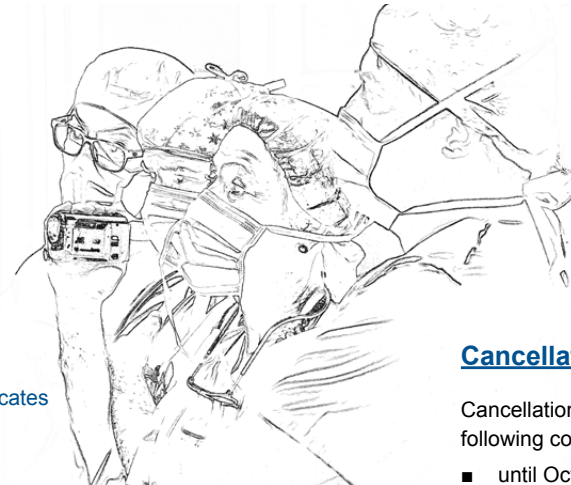
